

Travel Vaccination Update

With summer fast approaching many of us will be thinking of jetting off to sunnier climates, however visiting other countries can sometimes put individuals at risk of diseases not normally found in the UK. No-one wants to become ill during their holiday therefore start planning as soon as possible – book your holiday – book your vaccinations if required.

The NHS advise that you start to arrange vaccinations at least 8-12 weeks before you depart for your holiday, this will ensure any vaccinations provided take full effect before travelling. Although the most common destinations for UK travellers are considered low risk there are certain destinations, specific advice, vaccinations or additional protection, such as anti-malarias that might be necessary. Getting risk assessed and vaccinated against certain diseases before travelling is one of the most effective things a traveller can do to protect their health abroad. Some vaccinations are given as a precaution, while others may be required to enter a particular country. For further information, visit www.fitfortravel.nhs.uk.
